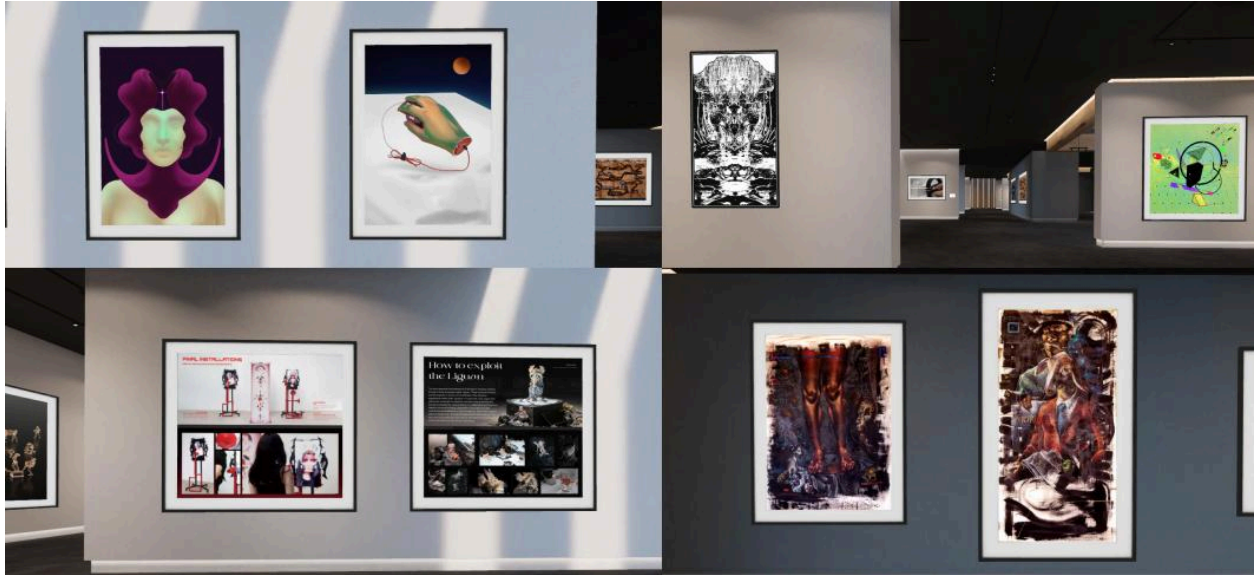




**Synthetica and Alterica: Silicon Valley International Contemporary Art Review Exhibition Announces Award Winners**
